INFORMATION TO ASSIST YOU

We find the best programs to use are:

MAC: iMovie, VideoPad **WINDOWS:** Movie Maker (Pre Windows 10), Photo App (Windows 10) and VideoPad

- As a rough guideline, photos should be on screen between 4-6 seconds.
- We find it best to keep it within 8 minutes, so usually no more than 80 photos (Quality over Quantity)
- The length of music chosen should be considered in relation to the amount of images. Please **embed your chosen music** into the photo tribute.
- Ensure you design it in a 16:9 widescreen ratio.
- Please remember to either save or export your presentation as a **.MOV** or **.MP4** format.

WHAT WE SUPPORT

Please provide your photo presentation with your chosen music embedded on a USB, or emailed via wettransfer.com as a **.MOV** or **.MP4** format.

WHAT WON'T WORK

Our system **does not support** Microsoft Powerpoint or Windows Media Video (**.wmv**) files

TEST IT ON OUR SYSTEM

Please bring your presentation to our offices **by 10am the day prior** to the service to ensure it is compatible in our system.
